FedInvest System

View Access - This role is for employees of federal agencies or their contractors who need to view or audit GAS portfolios. View Access enables a user to view investment and redemption transactions and produce reports in FedInvest for specific Treasury Account Symbols. Choose your desired account(s) in the Section 4 "FedInvest View Access" drop-down lists.

Case Management System

Clerk Update – This role is for employees of federal agencies or their contractors who manage individual case balances available for investment within their district. Clerk Update access enables a user to establish new cases; record deposits, withdraws, and transfers; and run activity and balance reports for their district. Choose the appropriate district from the "CMS Update Access" drop-down list in Section 4 below.

Clerk View - This role is for employees of federal agencies or their contractors who need to view individual case balances available for investment within their district. Clerk View access enables a user to view case balances and transactions and run reports for their district. Choose the appropriate district from the "CMS View Access" drop-down list in Section 4 below.

Fund Manager Update – This role is for employees of federal agencies or their contractors who manage GAS portfolios and view individual case balances. Fund Manager Update access enables a user to post investment and redemption transactions and produce reports in FedInvest for specific Treasury Account Symbols, as well as view case balances and transactions and run reports for all districts and perform certain administrative duties. No further action will be required for Step 4, the correct data will automatically populate.

Fund Manager View – This role is for employees of federal agencies or their contractors who need to view individual case balances within all districts. Fund Manager View access enables a user to view case balances and transactions and run reports for all districts. No further action will be required for Step 4, the correct data will automatically populate.

CMS Auditor View – This role is for auditors who need to view individual case balances within all districts. CMS Auditor View access enables a user to view case balances and transactions and run reports for all districts. No further action will be required for Step 4, the correct data will automatically populate.

GAS Accountant – This role is for internal users only. No further action will be required for Step 4, the correct data will automatically populate.
